## FOREWORD

Importance of availability of information on ongoing research projects had been discussed at various levels. NARESA identifying the need for such information to serve the scientific community for better utilization of resources available for scientific research launched a survey to collect information on ongoing research.

NARESA initiated the first survey in 1991 on this issue. This covered most of the research institutions except IFS, TRI and NERD. A computer database was created from the survey data. The summary of survey results was circulated among all the relevant organizations. However, it remains unpublished.

During the survey, it was noted that some of the institutions maintain their own ongoing research data bases. Some of them are CARP, VRI, University of Moratuwa and University of Peradeniya. (Summary of survey results of the 1991 survey is given in the annexure 1). Acquiring the above experience, NARESA initiated the second attempt to update the above data base for 1993/94.

These attempts were mostly centralized to scientific research activities outside Agricultural sector, so as not to duplicate CARP activities. However, some of the agricultural research centres responded to the NARESA questionnaire and therefore, it was decided to include those information also in the present report. Under these circumstances, the total number of ongoing research projects during 1993/94 is 654. The poor response from the Universities contributed to the level of incompleteness of the database. Although a comprehensive set of data such as funding agency, budget, keywords, project summary etc were collected, only the basic information are presented in the directory. The data are presented in the way that the Japanese research data on ongoing projects were published.

Finally, we would like to suggest that this data base should be updated once in two years. The data should be made available to researchers in the country through improved information exchange method such as E. mail. Furthermore, combined efforts with CARP and CISIR on this type of survey could be more productive.

Follow up of the completed projects are being made in the 1995 survey, with a view to record the research output.

Any productive criticism on this report is most appreciated.

Data on current research activities carried out by individual researchers as well as organizations were collected through questionnaires and personnel interviews. The overall percentage of response was about 75% . However, it was possible to obtain almost 100% response from the following organisations.

Atomic Energy Authority (AEA) , Agrarian Research & Training Institute (ARTI), Bandaranaike Memorial Ayurvedic Research Institute (BMARI), Central Blood Bank (CBB), Central Rice Breeding Station (CRBS), Coconut Research Institute (CRI), Co-operative Wholesale Establishment (CWE), Department of Export Agriculture (DEA), Department of Forest (DF), Department of National Museums (DNM), Department of Wild life Conservation (DWC), Industrial Development Board (IDB), Land & Water Management Research Centre (LWMRC), Marga Institute (MI), Medical Research Institute (MRI), National Aquatic Resources Agency (NARA), National Building Research Organisation (NBRO), National Institute of Education (NIE), Palmyrah Development Board (PDB), Plant Genetic Resource Centre (PGRC), Post Graduate Institute of Agriculture (PGIA), Rubber Research Institute (RRI), State Timber Corporation (STC), Veterinary Research Institute (VRI), Water Resources Board (WRB).

The major institutions that were not fully covered were Tea Research Institute and Sugar Cane Research Institute. However, information from periodicals/ publications that included some information on research projects have been collected.

Apart from that, with regard to these institutions which did not return the completed questionnaires , data was collected through interviews. However, in such instances all individual personnel within the institution were not available at the time of the visit. Follow up letters and personal calls also failed. Therefore, for some institutions 100% data collection could not be carried out ( Irrigation Department, University of Colombo and CISIR falls into this category).

The head office of the Department of Agriculture provided a list of research projects of their Regional Agricultural Research Stations. Simultaneously, some regional centres also provided information according to our format. ( Regional centre at Angunakolapalassa and Makandura). The later information were included in the main data base. The rest of the information, provided by the Head Office was recorded separately since it was noted that such information was based on the activities planned to be carried out during 1990, and may have not reflected the actual projects that were underway. (Regional centres at Mahailuppallama, Bombuwela and Aralaganwila).

Although PGRC, LWMRC and CARI comes under the Department of Agriculture they were reported separately. In addition, the following 14 institutions have reported one research project each.

Anti-Malaria Campaign (AMC), Central Council of Social Services (CCSS), Central Environmental Authority (CEA), Department of Education (DOE), Department of Inland Fisheries (DIF), Department of Labour (DL), Ministry of Health Services (MHS), Natural Resources Energy & Science Authority (NARESA), National Cancer Institute (NCI), Paddy Marketing Board (PMB), Sri Lanka Broadcasting Corporation (SLBC), Sri Lanka Technical College (SLTC), University of Pali & Buddhist Studies (UPBS).

Finally, it should be mentioned that no information could be collected from the North and Eastern Provinces except PDB of Jaffna and few other research projects of which the data were already available with NARESA

More than 50% of projects fall into the Agricultural sector and in contrast only very few projects were carried out within the fields of Environmental sciences and Socio-Economic Development.

The number of active researchers in the country was reported as 767, but the estimated number could be around 850, considering the fact that non responding institutions were about 25% .

Since the questionnaire was circulated only among the institutions, individual researchers who are not attached to institutions but carry out research activities individually, could not be included.
