PERMIT PROCEDURE	<i>Regulation and control of development activities for orderly development.</i>
COASTAL ZONE ADVISORY COUNCIL	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Ensures inter-agency cooperation and consultation in CZM Plan preparation and implementation.</i>• <i>Provides a forum for resolution of use conflicts.</i>
SURVEY OF THE COASTAL ZONE AND PREPARATION OF THE CZM PLAN	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Ensures planned development of coastal areas based on good information.</i>• <i>Ensures existing use patterns will be given due regard in Plan preparation.</i>• <i>Establishes a mechanism for the resolution of present and possible future use conflicts.</i>• <i>Establishes a Zoning scheme</i>• <i>Establishes a mechanism for Public participation.</i>• <i>Specifies implementation procedures and guide-lines for Plan implementation.</i>
PUNITIVE ACTION	<i>Prescribes deterrent punishment for violation of the provisions of the law.</i>
